2018 Mid-year Statistics Summary

- Ensured **539 animals** received veterinary care (surgery or consultation)
- De-sexed **197 dogs and cats**
- Treated additionally **245 dogs and cats** for injury or illness
- Provisioned **2037** doses of parasite care for dogs and cats
- Provisioned **250** parvovirus vaccines for dogs
- Recruited **14 veterinarians and vet nurses** to deliver **755 volunteer hours on island**
- Each vet or nurse volunteer gifted approximately **54 professional hours on island**
- Received approx **148 hours** support from volunteer staff in New Zealand to co-ordinate these activities
